Black Saturday Royal Commission highlights the need for Forest Fuel Reduction – are the Greens consistent?

Monday August 2, 2010. “Has our Government, or have the Greens, done any Due Diligence on these meaningless, flawed and destructive Green Policies?”

Chris Dawson, the Senate Candidate for the Climate Sceptics Party in Victoria, asks.

Against the Greens flawed policies, the Royal Commission into the Black Saturday bushfires recommends fuel reduction burn-offs of Crown land. The scientific experts recommended fuel reduction on 12% of Crown land per year, based on years of experience and empirical science from Western Australia.

Do the Greens accept this science, as they don't like fuel reduction presumably because it changes the forest and generates carbon dioxide? However, wildfires change forests disastrously and generate far more CO₂.

“The Greens Policies are now the problem and not the solution.”

The Greens Party 'lost its way' with no Due Diligence on many of its policies and no Due Diligence on Man Made Global Warming. How are humans affected?

“Each of us will pay more than we've been led to believe for Greens Policies”

The Greens can't show us any empirical evidence that increasing CO₂ concentrations in the atmosphere is the main cause of Global Warming, because there is no such evidence.

The Climate Sceptics Party is calling for a Royal Commission into the causes of Climate Change (Natural versus Man Made) and into the costs and benefits of dealing with Climate Change. Proper Due Diligence at last.

Please ensure the Greens don't get the balance of power in the Senate.
